liquidation and bankruptcy; The contract of goods traffic through which the sale of goods and services,

technology, industrial and intellectual property, foreign investments, as well as securities with special emphasis

on the bill and check are realized.

Practical classes: Getting to know the essential elements of the matter stated in the content of the case, especially in the form of legal workshops where the founding acts of companies are presented and made, their amendments are made, the conclusion of economic contracts and the drafting and filling of bills. Preparation of colloquium and exams. Evaluation of realized teaching and analysis of its results.
